Komen Tidewater for a night of fun and breast cancer awareness as the Peninsula Pilots take on the Petersburg Generals. During the game members of the Komen Tidewater family and breast cancer survivors will participate in various traditional baseball activities, including throwing out the first pitch, singing the National Anthem, announcing "Play Ball!" and singing "Take Me Out to the Ballgame."
